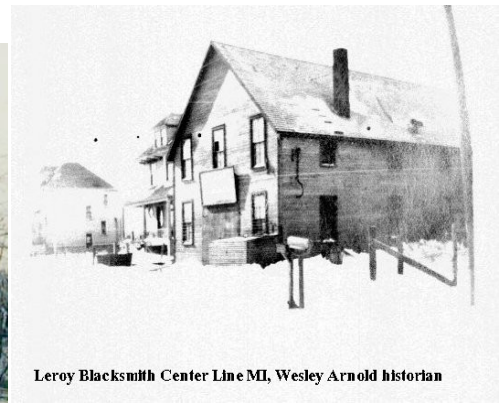
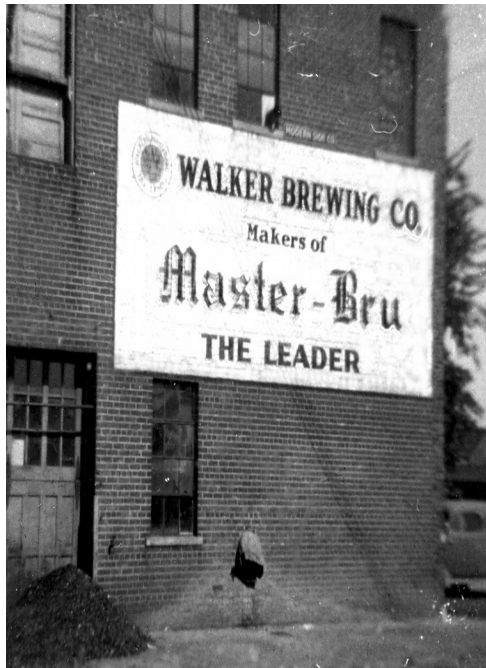


Old Businesses 2
