SABAUGH Judge Sabaugh is very proud of his Italian, Lebanese and Polish heritage. He and his wife Rachel reside in Warren with their three children (Alexander, Sophia and Gabrielle.) Judge Sabaugh started the “Court in School” Program in 2008, in which actual court cases are seen by Middle School and High School students. This program allows students to



witness the dangerous consequences of drug and alcohol abuse. The program has received positive feedback from students, teachers and school administrators. Judge Sabaugh is a board member of the Traffic Safety Association of Macomb County. He is also a member of the State Bar of Michigan, Macomb County Bar Association, Michigan District Judges Association, Italian-American Bar Association, Warren Kiwanis Club, and the Detroit Zoological Society. He served as a mentor in Governor Granholm's 2000 for 2000 Mentor Initiative. In 2008, Judge Sabaugh received the Resolution Center Conflict Resolution Advocacy Award. "Unreceptive certainly describes the attitude encountered by recently upgraded* Army Staff Sergeant John Sexton, who in 1971 was suddenly and without warning released from a VC prison camp near the Cambodian border. The possibility existed that the camp was actually inside a part of Cambodia controlled by communist guerrillas. It was difficult for POWs to decipher their precise location. At first Sexton was accompanied by NVA soldiers who made him walk point, as the Air Force man killed by First Force Recon had been made to do, but he was then abandoned near the small town of Snoul in Cambodia to make his own way back. Sexton, who was dressed in black pyjamas and carried a message from the communists asking for reciprocity for his release, said that once he reached American lines no one on his own side was interested, other than to impress upon him that he was to keep his mouth shut. For a long time he felt that it might have been more convenient for his own side if he had died in prison camp. For years after his return, he could not speak at meetings held by the families of other prisoners without an ever-present government representative to insure his

silence. He still feels that his own government had somehow become persuaded that he had been turned by the communists and that was why he had been chosen to be released. His only crime was to have fallen into the hands of the enemy after being severely wounded. He was shot in the head, blinded in one eye, and incapacitated in one arm. His medical care was minimal but he is still grateful that the enemy applied the primitive medicine of setting maggots to clean out his wounds. He suffered torture and interrogation for two years. There was never any proof that he had in any way collaborated with the enemy.

Kurt Mccrary stated: For 26 months **Sexton** never talked to another American. He lived in a 4 by 8 foot shelter in the ground where he was unable to stand erect. A half-inch under 6 feet, Sexton once was a thick-chested 185 pounds. He lost 50 pounds. At night, when he was **shackled, mice crawled in his hair**. He went months without a bath; it was a constant struggle not to lose his mind. He thought at times of just giving up and dying.

always friendly. Sometimes he would cut us notepads on his big cutting machine. He sold me a hectograph printer. Later I used to buy stencils supplies for my memograph printing machine. He was always friendly to us. He wrote and printed newspapers, booklets, stationery and all things printers print. He edited with Bert Hazen and printed the Weekly Review in the 1930s. He was an active city council member in Warren and a Board member of Center Line Public Schools. I wanted to get him to write a history book but he was always too busy. What a loss as he knew a lot that we will never know.

He served also on Warren's Charter Commission during 1956-57 and worked diligently to see that administrative, judicial and legislative bodies were set up to assure taxpayers that hasty decisions or partisan agendas were stalled by deliberate debate. As part of the Commission, he sought outside advice of experts on what form of government worked best for the third largest city in Michigan. He was a dedicated history buff and was often sought out by reporters writing stories on Warren's early days. He served on the Cultural Commission as well, and was recognized numerous times as a Citizen of the Year or for special honors by organizations. Mr. Stilwell, born in 1907, was survived by his wife Rose and two children, Judy and Ray, when he died in 1987. By Fred Gemmill
