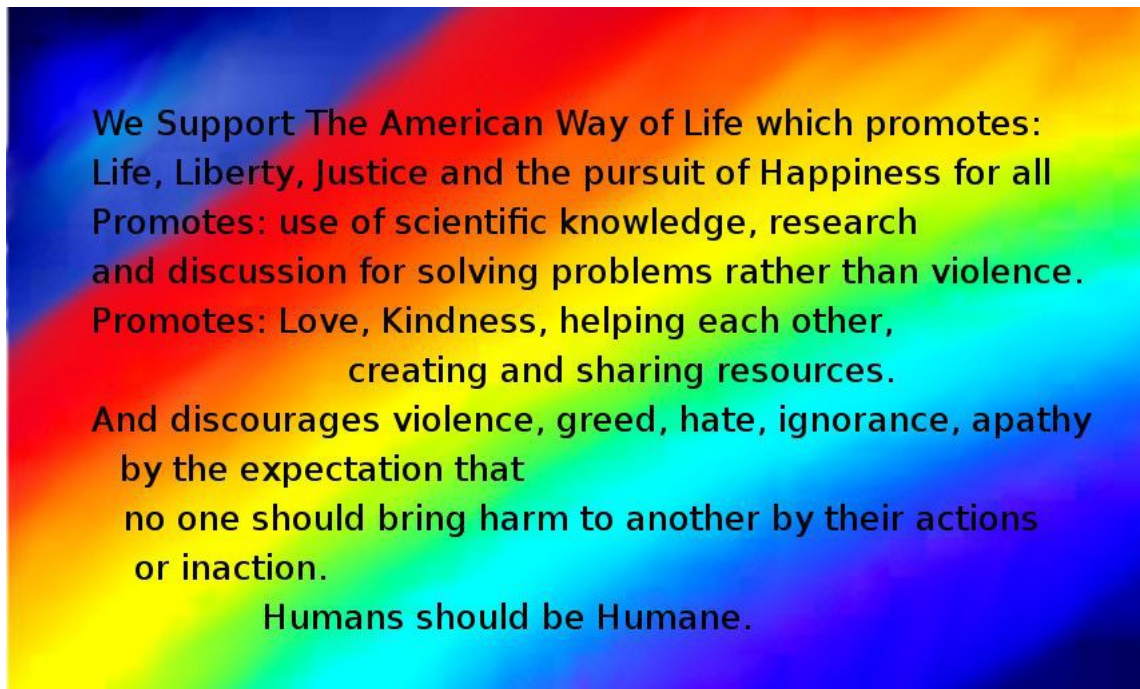

Thompson Max As someone who had seen an educational system working from the elementary right through to the top administrative post of Superintendent of the Van Dyke Public School System, Max Thompson was perhaps the most logical person to see the value of a community college in his community and to successfully work for its

establishment in 1954. For these and other accomplishments, the Greater Warren Chamber of Commerce honored Mr. Thompson in 1964 as Citizen of the Year. While he was apparently surprised at the dinner ceremony, those attending certainly were aware of the reasons for the honor being bestowed. They knew that he had served his nation in World War II in the U.S. Navy's medical services based in San Diego, California, was active in the Boy Scouts, Red Cross, Rotary Club, United Foundation and various educational associations and committees. Tranchida Peter He was an attorney who served in Center Line City government for fourteen years. He started as a councilman in 1968 and became Mayor of Center Line from 1969-1981. It appears that he was well liked by all. As neighbors one street over I had had many dealings with him and the result was always positive. He was asked many years later and long after he had retired from being a mayor to write a reflection about the times. This is what he wrote. "It was my philosophy to continue and improve upon the somewhat unique services rendered by the Community. It was there, with those intentions, that many of the services were maintained and expanded upon during my years in office. These services obviously were desired by the community at large, and the citizenry was willing to tax itself to provide for such things as sidewalk clearing and snow removal, twice per week rubbish collection, ambulance service, and numerous recreation and library functions, amongst other things.

...I have decided to talk about my feelings toward the Community and its people. My mother's family, the Buechels, were residents of the locale even prior to

Center line's becoming a Village, and therefore, my sense of belonging, in relationship to the people of the Community, was and is extremely deep-rooted. There always seemed to be a certain uniqueness about Center Line, and although difficult to put into words, it involves the size of the Community, its geographical location, and more particularly, the attitude and spirit of the residents of the City. It has been apparent to me, from past to present, that there is a colloquial pride and sense of belonging: pride in one's family, one's church, one's school, and pride of home ownership. I can, with warm recollection, recall, at public gatherings, church activities, 4th of July celebrations, or whatever, people taking the time to talk to each other, to know and to care about each other. There is a reunion atmosphere, for example, when the Lions Club holds its annual breakfast. As the pace of the world seems to quicken, and the events of the day preoccupy and usurp our time, the opportunities to gather and communicate and relate to each other are indeed precious and unique. As there still exists that certain friendly, rural attitude. A part of these qualities, and the help of my fellow Council members, that allowed me to create an atmosphere in which our Community could persevere and overcome the problems that evolved during the years I held office. I can recall our former Congressman Nedzi making that same observation when reflecting upon the success of our Urban Renewal Program. It is with these warm and wonderful memories that I wish the Community the very best in its future, and for the well-being of all its citizens. With warm regards Peter J Tranchida Former Mayor”
